ABOUT THIS COURSE

This accredited online course is designed to equip learners with the essential principles and practices necessary for sustainable and regenerative rangeland management. It is a valuable resource for individuals directly or indirectly involved in veld and land management.

Upon successful completion of this course, learners will receive credit-bearing certificates under the authority of AgriSeta. This course is recognized as an NQF 4 course, and the minimum qualification required for enrolment is Grade 11. It aligns with the SAQA unit standard titled “Implement a Natural Resource Management Plan” (Unit standard ID 116303). The course consists of 4 modules and 35 lessons. The following modules are included:

MODULE 1: INTRODUCTION

This module looks at what veld and natural resource management entail and discusses the important legislation dealing directly or indirectly with veld and land management.

MODULE 2: NATURAL RESOURCES

This module looks at the natural resources we are dealing with during land management. The natural resources and topics included in this module are soil and geology, vegetation, biomes, sweetveld and sourveld, climate, climate change, biodiversity and wetlands.

MODULE 3: PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICES

This module is the main module and includes all the important ecological principles and practices that need to be recognised and considered for sustainable and regenerative veld and land management.

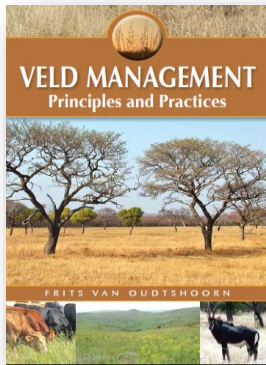
MODULE 4: GENERAL MANAGEMENT PRACTICES
